What is a Judged Pleasure Ride?

Ten fun and challenging obstacles will be encountered, each having a **one minute time limit** for completion. A *walk* is the requested pace, as other riders can appear suddenly.

COMMON SENSE is expected from all participants. This includes the handling of your horse, interactions with Judged Pleasure Ride staff, as well as fellow participants. Ride staff decisions are final.

The ride begins at Artillery Ridge Campground, which borders both the Judged Pleasure Ride area as well as the bridle trails of the Gettysburg National Military Park.

PLEASE NOTE: Check our website at the beginning of September to view expectations for optimal score achievement at each obstacle. If desired, please print and bring with you on ride day, as extra copies will not be available.

Welcome to the Tenth Annual GEHS Judged Pleasure Ride!

SCORING

The ribbon received will depend on your final score. Ribbons will be awarded in the following format out of a possible 100 points, 10 possible points for each obstacle:

- 97-100 pts. = Championship Ribbon
- 94-96 pts. = Reserve Championship Ribbon
- 90-93 pts. = First Place Ribbon (Blue)
- 84-89 pts. = Second Place Ribbon (Red)
- 78-83 pts. = Third Place Ribbon (Gold)
- 72-77 pts. = Fourth Place Ribbon (White)
- 66-71 pts. = Fifth Place Ribbon (Pink)
- 60-65 pts. = Sixth Place Ribbon (Green)
- 54-59 pts. = Seventh Place Ribbon (Purple)
- 1- 53 pts. = Eighth Place Ribbon (Brown)

Participants carry their score cards with them. The judge at each station scores and initials your card. Upon ride completion, present your score card for a ribbon. Participants will also receive their evaluation form at this time. Please place the form in the "evaluation basket" when picking up your lunch. We strive to improve each year!

LUNCH (included in entry fee)
